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Beginning Cohort: Students who are not in High School, enrolled for the first time at any postsecondary institution as a non-High School student. This cohort is tracked each subsequent Fall and Spring for four years.

Retained: Students from the Beginning Cohort who are enrolled at this college for the term reported. Students can be counted in one term, absent from the next, and then counted again as Retained in a subsequent term if they return (as long as they haven't transferred out or graduated, see next definition).

Transferred Out or Graduated: Students from the Beginning Cohort who have either Transferred Out to a Four Year Institution (based on a National Student Clearinghouse data match), or Graduated from this college, sometime between the cohort term and the end of the term reported. Once a student Transfers Out or Graduates, the student will continue to be counted in all subsequent "Transfer/Graduated" columns, and that student is no longer counted in the remaining "Retained" columns even if he or she returns to the college.
