# **CLT Program Admission**

Students seeking admission to the Clinical Laboratory Technology (CLT) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring Semester 2016. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Science Certificate*.

The admission criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **340 points**. See the CLT Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

## **Transfer Students / Transfer Credit**

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by spring semester 2016. The College's document deadline is December 11, 2015.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, December 11, 2015.

## **TEAS for Allied Health (5.0) ATI Assessment Test** (formerly HOBET V)

Students must take the <u>TEAS for Allied Health</u> (formerly HOBET) Version 5.0 by <u>Wednesday, May 11, 2016</u> and achieve a minimum total adjusted score of <u>65.00</u>.

A student may take the TEAS for Allied Health <u>two (2) times in a calendar year</u> and <u>must wait a minimum of</u> <u>30 calendar days</u> in between attempts. <u>A TEAS for Allied Health/HOBET score is valid for five years and the Clinical Laboratory Technology Program will use the highest score.</u>

The <u>TEAS for Allied Health</u> is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. The TEAS for Allied Health is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Continuing Education Department. If the TEAS for Allied Health (HOBET) has been taken at another college or testing center, the report must be sent from ATI to Chattahoochee Technical College.

### **Application Session**

Applicants must attend an Application Session during Spring Semester 2016. Applications are only distributed during application sessions. The schedule for the application sessions will be posted on the CLT webpage on the college's website at the beginning of Spring Semester.

#### **Final Class Selection**

Final class selection is based upon the total number of **Admission Points.** The students with the highest point value will be accepted into the program.

#### Orientation

If admitted into the CLT program, all students must attend a mandatory orientation during Summer Semester 2016.
