



## Emergency Medical Services Professions Diploma Spring Semester 2015

### Program Location

North Metro – Day Program

### College Admission

Students seeking admission to the Emergency Medical Services Professions (EMSP) Program must be fully admitted to the college for fall semester 2014. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college’s Healthcare Assistant Certificate.

EMSP program admission criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **160 points**. See the EMSP Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

### Transfer Students / Transfer Credit

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by fall semester 2014. The College’s document deadline for fall semester 2014 is July 25, 2014.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college’s document deadline, July 25, 2014.

## **HOBET**

Take the Health Occupations Basic Entrance Test (HOBET) Version 5.0 by **Tuesday, November 4, 2014**. Students and **achieve a minimum Adjusted Individual Total score of 54 or higher**.

A student may take the HOBET **two (2) times in a calendar year** and **must wait a minimum of 30 calendar days** in between attempts. A TEAS score is valid for five years and CTC will use the highest score.

The HOBET is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Continuing Education Department. If the HOBET was taken at another college, the report **must** be sent from ATI to Chattahoochee Technical College.
