College Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Medical Coding Specialization of the Health Care Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college and enrolled in the college's *Health Care Assistant Certificate* to take designated courses. Once all courses are completed, students will be able to petition for graduation to receive a Health Care Assistant Certificate.

Students should complete the required pre-requisite courses with a grade of "C" or better:

Please note: Students may take BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L and BIOL 2114, BIOL 2114L in lieu of ALHS 1011. BIO 2113/2113L and 2114/2114L are not approved courses for the *Health Care Assistant Certificate Program*, and cannot be taken while a student is enrolled in that program of study.

Students meeting the compass score requirements for college level course are permitted to enroll in ENGL 1101, PSYC 1101 and/or MATH 111 while in the Health Care Assistant Certificate Program.

Upon completion of the Medical Billing and Coding courses, and self-exam preparation review, students will be prepared to sit for the American Academy of Professional Coder's Certified Professional Coder exam (CPC).
