Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Chattahoochee Tech uses ONE Application for All Financial Aid. Complete the **FAFSA** to be considered for all financial aid including HOPE Grant/Scholarship, Zell Miller, SIWDG, Pell Grant, SEOG, etc.

Fall Semester 2014	Complete 2014-2015 FAFSA Using 2013 Income

STEP One: To complete your FAFSA, go to <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>. You will need your completed federal income tax returns (and your parent's information if you are "dependent"). If you are not required to file taxes, you will still need to provide income information. Include school code: **005620**.

Dependent Students:

- Under age 24 by January 1st of aid year
- Single
- No dependent children
- Not an orphan/ward of the court/State
- Not a Veteran

Copies of federal tax return cannot be accepted for Verification purposes. For faster processing, use the LINK to the IRS DATA RETRIEVAL TOOL to import your tax information.

STEP Two: In completing the FAFSA, you (and your parents, if required) will sign the application using an **electronic PIN**. If you don't have a PIN, you will apply for a PIN and use it to sign the FAFSA at the same time. Pin website for questions: <http://www.pin.ed.gov>.

After your FAFSA is processed by the Department of Education, CTC (and any other school(s) listed) will automatically receive this information. You will then be notified if additional information is required. If no further information is needed for processing, you will receive an award letter detailing your financial aid eligibility. **Check your CTC Student Email account regularly** for important financial aid updates. You will also receive your SAR (Student Aid Report) via mail or e-mail.

Check your financial aid status in BannerWeb. Go to me@CTC and log onto BannerWeb using your ID and PIN. In BannerWeb, you can view Required Documents, Financial Aid Award Amounts, Tuition and Fee Balances and Authorized Financial Aid and also Satisfactory Academic Progress.

If you have registered for the upcoming semester, you must adhere to the posted fee payment deadlines (**see Bursars Office Website**) for the semester in which you are planning to attend. If payment is not made or your financial aid file is not complete by the deadline, your classes will be dropped for non-payment.
