COMPASS is a placement exam. It determines whether you will be required to take learning support courses in English and Math. Make sure you come prepared to do your best!

Photo ID is required. Please allow 2-3 hours to complete the test. You may be asked to stop your test if you have not finished testing by the time the lab closes. Scratch paper, pencils, and calculators will be provided. Please do not bring cell phones or calculators with you.

Retesting is ONLY allowed for NEW students and you may retest ONLY one time.

Retesting requires a \$15 fee. Students may not retake the test on the same day as their initial attempt.

PARENTS: Children are not allowed in the testing area.
