


Use your student ID number (900) and Banner web PIN to log in

I Need Books

- 1. Click on <u>Library Catalog</u> on the CTC Library homepage.
- Enter search terms (words or phrase, title, author, etc.);
 select Electronic Book Library under the <u>library</u>:
 pull down; submit the search.
- 3. Review results select any Online Resource book,
 - click on the URL or the
 - Ebrary & Credo Reference enter your student ID # to view the book.
 - EBSCOhost: Username: chattech & Password: CTC + GALILEO Password
 - Project Gutenbook ebooks are free

What do I need to do?

Learn how to Access your Online Library
 Account (over) – you'll be able to access <u>all</u>
 CTC library online resources from home as long
 as your account is active;

or

 You visit any CTC library once a semester to get <u>GALILEO</u>, <u>Facts On File</u>, <u>Global Road Warrior</u>, <u>Newsbank</u>, and other resource passwords.

With the <u>GALILEO</u> password, access journal, magazine and newspaper articles from any of the <u>GALILEO</u> databases, and access other resources, for example:

- Encyclopedias— log into GALILEO, click on Databases A-Z tab, select E, scroll down to Encyclopedia Britannica Online; or Select C, scroll down to Credo Reference
- Literary Criticism— log into GALILEO, click on Databases A-Z tab, select L, scroll down to <u>Literature Resource Center (Gale)</u> or <u>Literary Reference Center</u>
- Images log into GALILEO, click on Databases A-Z tab, select I, scroll down to <u>Image Quest</u>; Millions of images available for non-commercial educational purposes
