COMPASS is a placement exam. It determines whether you will be required to take learning support courses in English and Math. Make sure you come prepared to do your best!

Please allow 2-3 hours to complete the test. <u>Photo ID is required.</u> Scratch paper, pencils, and calculators will be provided. Please do not bring cell phones, calculators with you.

Retesting is ONLY allowed for NEW students and you may retest ONLY one time.

Retesting requires a \$15 fee. You may not retake the test on the same day as your initial attempt.

PARENTS: Children are not allowed in the testing area.

Chattahoochee Technical College's **Canton Campus** has daily walk-in hours for the COMPASS Placement testing.

• Walk-In Testing: Students may arrive at any time during the given time period to take the test. Testing will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
