### **College Admission**

Students seeking to register for courses in the Central Sterile Processing Technician Option of the Healthcare Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college, enroll in the college's *Healthcare Assistant Certificate/Health Occupations Certificate* to take pre-admission courses and complete or have all transfer credit entered into CTC's Banner System by **Monday, August 10, 2015**. Admission into the concentration is limited to 10 students and based on the following criteria and deadlines.
