College Admission

Students seeking to register for courses in the Central Sterile Processing Technician Option of the Healthcare Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college, enroll in the college's *Healthcare Assistant Certificate/Health Occupations Certificate* to take pre-admission courses and complete or have all transfer credit entered into CTC's Banner System by **Monday, August 10, 2015**. Admission into the concentration is limited to 10 students and based on the following criteria and deadlines.

Pre-Admission Coursework

The following pre-admission general education classes must be taken prior to registering for CSSP 1010 Central Sterile Processing Technician and CSSP 1020 Central Sterile Processing Technician Practicum. Complete or have transfer credit in CTC's Banner System for the following classes by **Monday, August 10, 2015** with a **grade of "C" or higher**:
