RAD Program Admission

Students seeking admission to the Radiography (RAD) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring Semester 2015. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Science Certificate/Health Occupations Certificate*.

RAD program admission criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **430 points**. See the RAD Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

Transfer Students / Transfer Credit

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by spring semester 2015. The College's document deadline for spring semester 2015 is December 13, 2014.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, December 12, 2014.

HOBET V (5.0)

Students must take the Health Occupations Basic Entrance Test (HOBET) Version 5.0 by **Wednesday 13, 2015** and achieve a minimum total adjusted score of **70.00**.

A student may take the HOBET <u>two (2) times in a calendar year</u> and <u>must wait a minimum of 30 calendar</u> <u>days</u> in between attempts. <u>A HOBET score is valid for five years and the Radiography Program will use the highest score.</u>

The HOBET is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at <u>www.atialliedhealth.com</u>. The HOBET is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Continuing Education Department. If the HOBET is taken at another college or testing center, the report must be sent from ATI to Chattahoochee Technical College.

Application Session

To apply to the program you <u>must attend</u> an Application Session during **Spring Semester 2015** to complete a program application. The sessions will be held at the North Metro Campus. Dates and times will be posted on the Radiography webpage.

Interview

Students will be selected for an interview based on their total points in all other categories. Once selected, students will be notified of dates and times for the interview. All qualified applicants may not receive an interview. The number of applicants interviewed is based on the number of qualified applicants and the number of seats available in the program cohort.
