ACADEMIC ADMISSION STEPS

Submit a completed <u>admission application</u> and a nonrefundable \$20.00 application fee in U.S. currency by credit card, money order or check drawn on a U.S. bank payable to Chattahoochee Technical College by the appropriate admission deadline.

Submit <u>official transcripts</u> from your high school (or GED) and all colleges attended by the application <u>deadline</u>. All transcripts must be received in envelopes sealed by the sending institution. Applicants with a college degree are not required to submit a high school or GED transcript. All international transcripts must be evaluated by an approved evaluation service and sent directly to CTC. We recommend the following evaluation agencies:
