# **HIMT Program Admission**

Students seeking admission to the Health Information Management Technology (HIMT) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring Semester 2015. To take pre-admission general education courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Science Certificate*.

HIMT program admission criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **230 points**. See the HIT Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

# **Transfer Students / Transfer Credit**

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by spring semester 2015. The College's document deadline for spring semester 2015 is December 12, 2014.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, December 12, 2014.

# **TEAS for Allied Health Version 5.0 ATI Assessment (formerly HOBET)**

Students must take the <u>TEAS for Allied Health Version 5.0 (HOBET)</u> by <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>May 13</u>, 2015. Students must achieve <u>an individual adjusted total score of 60.00</u> in order to be considered for the program.

A student may take the TEAS for Allied Health Version 5.0 two (2) times in a calendar year and must wait a minimum of 30 calendar days in between attempts. A <u>TEAS for Allied Health Version 5.0</u> (HOBET) score is valid for five years and CTC will use the highest score.

The TEAS for Allied Health Version is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. The TEAS for Allied Health Version HOBET is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Continuing Education Department. If the TEAS for Allied Health/HOBET was taken at another college or testing center, the report must be sent from ATI to Chattahoochee Technical College.

# **Application Session**

Applicants must attend an Application Session during Spring Semester 2015. Applications are only distributed during application sessions. The schedule for the application sessions will be posted on the HIMT webpage on the college's website at the beginning of Spring Semester.
