Scratch paper, pencils, and calculators will be provided. Please do not bring cell phones or calculators with you. PARENTS: Children are not allowed in the testing area.

Retesting is ONLY allowed for NEW students and you may retest ONLY one time.

All retesting requires a 1-day waiting period and \$15 retesting fee.
