

Business Management Degree Map

Step 1

Complete Learning Support courses if needed. *You can complete any of the following courses while completing your Learning Support courses:*

COMP1000 or COMP1500, MGMT1100, MGMT1105, MGMT1120, MGMT1115 and ENGL1101 (if you have the appropriate Compass test scores)

Select your specialization (General Management or Human Resources Management) early to ensure you are taking courses that will lead to a timely graduation.

Step 2

COMPLETE REMAINING GENERAL EDUCATION CORE REQUIREMENTS

(See the CTC Course Catalog for specific area courses)

Complete Area I: Language Arts/Communications (ENGL1101 is required – take now if not taken in Step One)

Complete Area II: Social/Behavioral Sciences (Recommend taking PSYC1101)

Complete Area III: Natural Sciences/Mathematics

Complete Area IV: Humanities/Fine Arts

Complete Area V: General Education Core Elective - Take any core class not already taken to fulfill one of the areas above (Recommend ENGL1102, SOCI1101 or SPCH1101)

While completing your General Education Core courses you may take any of the following:

ACCT1100, MGMT1100, MGMT1105, MGMT1115, MGMT1120, MGMT1125, MGMT2115, MGMT2125, MKTG1130 and Program Elective (this is an additional General Education Core class elective)

Step 3

Take the courses within your selected specialization

To prepare for graduation make sure you have completed your major courses and electives from one of those specializations. Meet with your advisor and complete your Petition for Graduation the semester before you plan on graduating.

General Management Specialization:

MGMT2135 and MGMT2150 are required. Select **two** additional from: MGMT2120, MGMT2130, MGMT2140, MGMT2140, MGMT2145, MGMT2210, ACCT1120, BUSN1430, LOGI1000, MKTG1100, MKTG2500 and SCMA1000.

Human Resources Management Specialization:

MGMT2120, MGMT2130, MGMT2210 are required courses. Take one additional course from: ACCT1120, BUSN1430, MKTG1100, MKTG2500, LOGI1000, SCMA1000

Complete MGMT2215 as one of your final courses.
