

# Emergency Medical Services Professions Diploma (EMT/AEMT) Spring 2017 Semester

#### **Program Location**

#### **College Admission**

Students seeking admission to the Emergency Medical Services Professions (EMSP) Program must be fully admitted to the College for Fall Semester 2016. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the College's Healthcare Assistant Certificate or Healthcare Science Certificate

EMSP program admission criteria consist of admission points with a total value of <u>220 points</u>. See the EMSP Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

#### Transfer Students / Transfer Credit

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Fall Semester 2016. <u>The College's document deadline for Fall semester 2016 is August 5, 2016.</u>

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the College's document deadline, **August 5, 2016**.
