COMPASS is a placement exam that tests students in reading, writing, and math. Your test results determine if you will need to complete learning support courses in English and math. Make sure you come prepared to do your best!

Photo ID is required. Please allow 2-3 hours to complete the test. You may be asked to stop your test if you have not finished testing by the time the lab closes. Scratch paper, pencils, and calculators will be provided. Please do not bring cell phones or calculators with you. PARENTS: Children are not allowed in the testing area.

New students may retake each section one time. Retesters must pay a \$15 retesting fee and must wait until the next calendar day to retest; there is no same-day retesting.

Testing is on a first come, first served basis.
