Special Populations Textbook Lending Application Instructions

The Textbook Lending Library is a service provided to eligible students to assist them with the financial burden of purchasing textbooks for their courses. To be eligible for the Textbook Lending Program, students must be a documented member of one or more of the student groups serviced by the Special Populations Department:

- 1. Economically Disadvantaged
- 2. Students with Disabilities
- 3. Displaced Homemaker
- 4. Limited English Proficiency
- 5. Enrolled in a Non-Traditional Program
- 6. Single Parent

To Apply for Textbook Lending Program:

- 1. Complete the Textbook Lending Application linked at the bottom of the Textbook Lending Program webpage.
- Save and attach the application, along with your class schedule, and email it to <u>CTCTextbooklending@chattahoocheetech.edu</u>. The application must come from your <u>CTC Student Email account.</u>
 - Incomplete applications will be delayed in processing
- 3. Check your CTC Student Email for notification from the Textbook Lending team
 - Students may or may not receive all of the books they have applied for
- 4. If approved, schedule your appointment to pick up your textbook(s) through the appointment link included in your notification email.
 - All students will not be eligible. Students who are ineligible will be notified by through the TBL email response.
