CLT Program Admission

Students seeking admission to the Clinical Laboratory Technology (CLT) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring Semester 2017. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Science Certificate*.

The admission criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **340 points**. See the CLT Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

Transfer Students / Transfer Credit

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Spring Semester 2017. The College's document deadline is December 16, 2016.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, December 16, 2016.

ATI TEAS

Take the **ATI TEAS by Friday, May 12, 2017 and achieve a minimum total adjusted score of 65.00.** A student may take the **ATI TEAS** <u>two (2) times in a calendar year</u> and <u>must wait a minimum of 30</u> <u>calendar days</u> in between attempts. <u>The **ATI TEAS** score is valid for five years.</u>

The ATI TEAS is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at <u>www.atitesting.com</u> The ATI TEAS is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Corporate and Professional Education Department,

<u>NOTE</u>: Chattahoochee Technical College is no longer accepting scores from previous versions of the TEAS, TEAS for Allied Health, or HOBET. The College will only use scores from the new version – ATI TEAS.

Application Session

Applicants must attend an Application Session during Spring Semester 2017. Applications are only distributed during application sessions. The schedule for the application sessions will be posted on the CLT webpage on the college's website at the beginning of Spring Semester.

Final Class Selection

Final class selection is based upon the total number of **Admission Points.** The students with the highest point value will be accepted into the program.

Orientation

If accepted into the program, all students must attend an orientation in August 2017.
