**\*Degree seeking students:**

Students may enroll in PSYC 1101 – Introduction to Psychology, Humanities Elective, or the General Education elective during the Paramedic program. Courses must be completed with a “C” or better. Due to the rigor of the program, students are strongly encouraged to complete these courses prior to beginning the Paramedic Program. Students who do not complete these three courses, PSYC 1101 – Introduction to Psychology, Humanities Elective, or the General Education elective, by December 15, 2017 will be awarded a Diploma in Paramedicine. After graduating from the paramedic program, students may enroll in these courses to meet the criteria to receive a degree in paramedic. Upon completion, students should petition to graduate for the AAS Degree in Paramedicine.
