College Admission

Students seeking admission to the Phlebotomy specialization of the Healthcare Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college and enrolled in the college's *Healthcare Assistant Certificate*.

Admission is limited and based on the following criteria and deadlines. Students should be aware that certain immunizations, negative drug screens and clean background checks are required for participation in the clinical portion of the program.

Students must register for both of the following course for the Spring semester:

*PHLT 1030 will be taught during the B term (first 8 weeks) on Tuesday and Thursday 1pm-4pm, and must be completed with a C or higher to move on to PHLT 1050.

**PHLT 1050 will be taught during the C term (second 8 weeks). Clinical Course – times and days will vary

Application Sessions

All students must attend an Application Session and complete a Program Application. Program applications are only given out at the Application Sessions. A schedule of the Phlebotomy Application Sessions will be posted on the Healthcare Assistant Certificate webpage.

Registration for PHLT courses will be available to those that have completed the above pre-admission courses, attended an application session and who register first. These courses will be limited to an enrollment of 12 students.
