Step 2: Complete remaining General Core requirements

- Area IV (choose 1)-> ARTS 1101 or ENGL 2130, or HUMN 1101 or MUSC 1101, or ENGL 2110 or THEA 1101

Note: To meet the minimum required 15 semester credit hours in General Core, an additional 3 semester credit hours must be selected from a course in Area I, Area II, Area III, or Area IV
