PN Program Admission

Students seeking admission to the Practical Nursing (PN) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Summer Semester 2017. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's Health Care Science or Health Care Assistant Certificate.

PN program admission criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **270 points**. See the PN Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

Transfer Students / Transfer Credit

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Summer Semester 2017. The College's document deadline for Summer Semester 2017 is Friday, May 19, 2017.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, **Friday, May 19, 2017.**

ATI TEAS

Take the **ATI TEAS by Friday, August 4, 2017 and achieve a minimum total adjusted score of 60.00.** A student may take the **ATI TEAS two (2) times in a calendar year** and **must wait a minimum of 30 calendar days** in between attempts. The **ATI TEAS** score is valid for five years.

The ATI TEAS is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at www.atitesting.com The ATI TEAS is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Corporate and Professional Education Department.

<u>NOTE:</u> Chattahoochee Technical College is no longer accepting scores from previous versions of the TEAS, TEAS for Allied Health, or HOBET. The College will only use scores from the new version – ATI TEAS.

Application Session

All students must attend a Practical Nursing Application Session and complete a Program Application. Program Applications are <u>only</u> given out at the Application Sessions. A schedule of Practical Nursing Application Sessions will be posted on the Practical Nursing webpage.

Final Class Selection

Final class selection is based upon the total number of **Admission Points.** The students with the highest point value will be accepted into the program.
