Radiography Fall Semester 2018

Program Location: North Metro Campus

RAD Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Radiography (RAD) Program must be fully admitted to the college for Spring Semester 2018. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's Healthcare Science Certificate or Interdisciplinary Studies-Health Track.

The Radiography program has a competitive admission process. The selection criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **320 points**. See the RAD Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

All students must have a CTC GPA of 2.0 or higher to be considered for program admission. If a student has all transfer credit, and does not have a CTC GPA, this requirement does not apply.

Transfer Students / Transfer Credit:

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Spring Semester 2018. The College's document deadline for Spring Semester 2018 is **Friday**, **December 8, 2017**.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, **Friday**, **December 8**, **2017**.

ATI TEAS:

Take the ATI TEAS by **Friday, May 4, 2018** and achieve a minimum total adjusted score of 70.00. A student may take the ATI TEAS two (2) times in a calendar year and must wait a minimum of 30 calendar days in between attempts. The ATI TEAS score is valid for five years.

The ATI TEAS is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at www.atitesting.com The ATI TEAS is available through the Chattahoochee Technical College's Corporate and Professional Education Department.

Application Session:

To apply to the program students must attend an Application Session during Spring Semester 2018 to complete a program application. Applications are distributed only at the application sessions. The sessions will be held at the North Metro Campus. A schedule will be posted on the Radiography webpage. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter the session.

Final Class Selection:

Final class selection is based upon the total number of Admission Points. The students with the highest point value will be accepted into the program.
