Veterans Emergency Assistance Fund - \$50,000

As an endowment administered by Chattahoochee Tech Foundation, the Veterans Emergency Assistance Fund would provide one-time grants to veterans in need of assistance with tuition, books, fees, or other personal expenses in order to maintain their enrollment status at Chattahoochee Technical College.

Stipend Fund for Veteran Mentors - \$25,000

In 2016, Chattahoochee Technical College launched a Veteran Mentorship Program to aid students in the transition from active military to civilian to student. This program pairs incoming veteran students with a currently enrolled veteran student as a mentor to provide insight and guidance as they progress through their educational career. A stipend fund would cover expenses for mentors' time and travel for meetings.
