Paramedic Program Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Paramedic Program must be fully admitted to the college for Fall Semester 2018. To take pre-admission courses, students should enroll in the college's *Healthcare Assistant Certificate*, *Healthcare Science Certificate* or *Interdisciplinary Studies Degree-Health Track*.

The Paramedic program has a competitive admission process. The selection criteria consist of Admission Points with a total value of **190 points**. See the Paramedic Admission Points Criteria sheet for additional information.

Transfer Students / Transfer Credit:

If you are a transfer student, you must be fully admitted to Chattahoochee Technical College by Fall Semester 2018. The College's document deadline for Fall Semester 2018 is **Friday**, **July 6**, **2018**.

If you are transferring college credit into Chattahoochee Technical College, official transcripts must be received by the college's document deadline, **Friday**, **July 6**, **2018**.

Required:

Students must hold a current certification or licensure as an EMT, AEMT, or EMT-I. Students should bring proof of current certification or licensure when attending an application session.

Additional Required Courses for Degree Seeking Students:

The following courses may be taken prior to admission or while a student is enrolled in the Paramedic program. All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. Due to the rigor of the program it is strongly encouraged that students complete these courses prior to admission.

Students who do not complete all the degree level courses by completion of the paramedic program will be awarded a Diploma in Paramedicine. After graduating from the paramedic program, students may enroll in these courses to meet the criteria to receive a degree in Paramedicine. Upon completion, students should petition to graduate for the AAS Degree in Paramedicine.

All students must attend an Application Session and complete a Program Application. Program applications are only given out at the Application Sessions. A schedule of Paramedic Application Sessions will be posted on the Paramedic webpage. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter the session.
