Students may enroll in the Humanities Elective and the General Education elective during the Paramedic program. Courses must be completed with a “C” or better. Due to the rigor of the program, students are strongly encouraged to complete these courses prior to beginning the Paramedic Program.

Students who do not complete all the degree level courses by the completion of the paramedic program will be awarded a Diploma in Paramedicine. After graduating from the paramedic program, students may enroll in these courses to meet the criteria to receive a degree in Paramedicine. Upon completion, students should petition to graduate for the AAS Degree in Paramedicine.
