Program: Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT)

Program Location: Marietta Campus

Admissions Format: Competitive Admissions. Applicants are ranked according to total admission points, and the applicants with the highest total points are offered available seats. Admission decisions are sent via Chatt Tech student email, typically in June each year.

Course Enrollment and Schedule: Closed enrollment, fixed sequence. Only students accepted to the MLT Program can enroll in MLBT courses. MLBT courses are taken in a fixed, pre-determined sequence each term. Schedule is full-time. On campus laboratory courses are typically held two days/week during the Spring and Summer semesters.

Program Length: Program is designed to be completed in a total of 7 semesters, including pre-requisites and occupational coursework.

Pre-requisites Courses: Recommended 2 semesters, 27 credits. Program prerequisite courses can be completed at any campus and in any order that follows college prerequisite requirements.

Occupational Coursework: Required 5 semesters, 46 credits. Occupational courses are completed in a fixed, pre-determined sequence.

Steps to Apply to Medical Laboratory Technology Program

Step 1: Apply to Chattahoochee Tech and be accepted.

Go to the [College Admissions webpage](#) to apply.

Student 900# and email address is required to apply to Health Sciences programs (Step 2).

Step 2: Apply to the specific Health Sciences Program.

Watch the Required Program Information Video before applying.

Application Open: April 01

Application Close: Last day of Spring Semester (A/C Terms) as listed on the [college calendar](#).

Step 3: Meet all admissions criteria by the published deadlines.

Spring Semester Deadline Items

Deadline for these items is the last day of Spring Semester (A/C Terms) as listed on the [college calendar](#). Points are awarded using the criteria described for each item. A grade of C or higher is required for all courses. Courses taken during Spring Semester will meet this deadline.

***Important Note:** Health Sciences Admissions criteria considers multiple courses in Areas I and III to award admission points, but you must have passing credit for courses ENGL 1101 and MATH 1111 to meet the requirements for this degree. If necessary, contact the [Records Office](#) to review your record.

Spring Transfer Credit

If coursework is completed at another institution during Spring Semester, please transfer the credit promptly to avoid errors with your application. If you experience a delay, email HealthSciences Admission HealthSciences.Admission@chattahoocheetech.edu to assist with your application.

Prerequisite High School Transfer Credit

High School Transfer credit is considered to meet ENGL 1101, MATH 1111, and PSYC 1101 courses only. Letter grade and points are awarded on the following criteria:

Highschool Credit	Scale
Advanced Placement (AP)	Minimum score is 3. 3 = C, 4 = B, 5 = A.
International Baccalaureate (IB)	Minimum score is 4. 4 or 5 = C, 6 = B, 7 = A
College Level Examination Program (CLEP)	Minimum score is 50. All scores 50 and above = C.

Optional Healthcare Certification – Spring Deadline

A Healthcare Certification is not required but can earn up to a maximum of 20 additional points towards application.

Students may earn 20 optional points if they hold a current and active certification or license in one of the following healthcare disciplines:

- Certified Phlebotomist (CPT)
- Certified Laboratory Assistant (CLA/CMLA)

Students may earn 10 optional points if they hold a current certification or license in one of the following healthcare disciplines:

- Licensed EMT or Advanced EMT
- Certified Medical Assistant (CMA)
- Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)
- Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT)
- Certified Dental Assistant (CDA)
- Certified Patient Care Technician (CPCT)
- Certified Sterile Supply Processing (CSSP/CRCST)
- Certified Endoscope Reprocessor (CER)

All documentation must be submitted using the link on the program webpage, “Medical Lab Technology Optional Healthcare Certification Submission”. Documents are uploaded via the college’s Etrieve Platform. Carefully follow the instructions provided on the form.

Please note: paper or emailed documentation will no longer be accepted. All documentation must be submitted electronically using the link provided on the program webpage.

Proof of Healthcare Certification must be submitted each application year. Documentation from a previous application will not be carried forward or accepted.

Deadline to submit Optional Items is the last day of Spring Semester (A/C Terms) as listed on the [college calendar](#).

Competitive Admissions Tie Breaker

In the event of a tie in total admissions points, the following criteria will be used in order to determined admission.

1. The applicant that holds a current Healthcare Certification as a Certified Phlebotomist or Laboratory Assistant will be ranked higher.
2. If a tie remains, the applicant that hold a current Healthcare Certification in any other the listed disciplines will be ranked higher.
3. If a tie remains, the applicant with the higher total GPA of all pre-requisite courses will be ranked higher.
4. If a tie remains, the applicant with the higher GPA in pre-requisite BIOL and CHEM courses will be ranked higher
5. If a tie remains, the applicant that attended the MLT Open House in the Spring of admission year will be ranked higher.

Summer Semester Deadline Items

Deadline for these items is the last day of Summer Semester as listed on the [college calendar](#). These items must be completed, but are not used to calculate admissions points. Students may apply to the program pending completion of items by the end of Summer Semester. Courses taken during Summer Semester will meet this deadline.
