

Three-Year Medical Laboratory Technology Program Outcomes

Graduates of the MLT Program are qualified to sit for national certification exams sponsored by the American Society of Clinical Pathologists (ASCP) Board of Certification (BOC) or American Medical Technologists (AMT). Program outcomes from the last three active years, including certification rates, graduation rates, and placement rates, are listed below as determined by guidelines from the National Accreditation Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences (NAACLS).

- **Certification Rate:** Data included for the number of students who attempted and passed an MLT certification exam within one year of graduation.
- **Graduation Rate:** Data included for the number of students who began the final half of the MLT Program and went on to successfully graduate.
- **Placement Rate:** Data included graduates who either found employment in the field or a closely related field or continued their education within one year of graduation.
