

# Health Sciences Program Admissions Guide

## Radiography Program

**Program:** Radiography (RAD)

**Credential(s) Awarded:** [Radiography Associate of Applied Science Degree](#)

**Program Location:** North Metro Campus

**Admissions Format:** Competitive Admissions. Applicants are ranked according to total admission points, and the applicants with the highest total points are offered available seats. Admission decisions are sent via Chatt Tech student email, typically in June each year.

**Course Enrollment and Schedule:** Closed enrollment, fixed sequence. Only students accepted to the RAD Program can enroll in RADT courses. RADT courses are taken in a fixed, pre-determined sequence each term. Schedule is full-time, Monday – Friday. Class hours typically 8:00am – 4:30pm, but schedule may vary for clinical experiences. Classes primarily in person with some hybrid/online portions.

**Program Length:** Program is designed to be completed in a total of 6 semesters, including pre-requisites and occupational coursework.

**Pre-requisites Courses:** Recommended 2 semesters. 25 credits. Program prerequisite courses can be completed at any campus and in any order that follows college prerequisite requirements.

**Occupational Coursework:** Required 4 semesters. 52 credits. Occupational courses are completed in a fixed, pre-determined sequence.

**\*Important Note:** Health Sciences Admissions criteria considers multiple courses in Areas I and III to award admission points, but you must have passing credit for courses ENGL 1101 and MATH 1111 to meet the requirements for this degree. ### Prerequisite High School Transfer Credit

High School Transfer credit is considered to meet ENGL 1101, MATH 1111, and PSYC 1101 courses only. Letter grade and points are awarded on the following criteria:

**ATI TEAS test must be taken in person at a Chattahoochee Technical College campus.** A student may take the ATI TEAS two (2) times in a calendar year and must wait a minimum of 30 calendar days in between attempts. The ATI TEAS score is valid for five years.

The ATI TEAS is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at ATI. The ATI TEAS is available through the [Chattahoochee Technical College's Testing Center](#).

Deadline to take the ATI TEAS is the last day of Spring Semester (A/C Terms) as listed on the [college calendar](#).

**Note:** after you complete the ATI TEAS on a Chattahoochee Technical College campus, scores will automatically be reported. You do not need to submit scores with your application.

## Optional Observation Hours – Spring Deadline

Observation hours are not required but can earn additional points towards application. Students may earn 10 optional points by completing observation hours by the deadline. See Instructions for Observation Hours in this document for instructions. Incomplete hours or documentation submitted after the deadline will not earn points.

All documentation must be submitted using the link on the program webpage, “Radiography Optional Observation Hours Submission”. Documents are uploaded via the college’s Etrieve Platform. Carefully follow the instructions provided on the form.

**Please note: paper or emailed documentation will no longer be accepted.** All documentation must be submitted electronically using the link provided on the program webpage. The only exception is documentation previously submitted during the 2026 application cycle and already on file with Health Sciences Admission.

Observation hours submitted with the 2025 application cycle or earlier will not be accepted. Observation hours submitted with the 2026 application cycle and currently on file with Health Sciences Admissions will be accepted.

Deadline to submit Optional Items is the last day of Spring Semester (A/C Terms) as listed on the [college calendar](#).

## Optional Healthcare Certification – Spring Deadline

A Healthcare Certification is not required but can earn additional points towards application. Students may earn 10 optional points if they hold a current and active certification or license in one of the following healthcare disciplines:

- Licensed EMT or Advanced EMT
- Certified Medical Assistant (CMA)
- Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)
- Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT)
- Certified Phlebotomist (CPT)
- Certified Dental Assistant (CDA)
- Certified Patient Care Technician (CPCT)
- Certified Sterile Supply Processing (CSSP/CRCST)
- Certified Endoscope Reprocessor (CER)
- Registered Imaging Assistant (I.A., MR) (ARRT)

All documentation must be submitted using the link on the program webpage, “Radiography Optional Healthcare Certification Submission”. Documents are uploaded via the college’s Etrieve Platform. Carefully follow the instructions provided on the form.

**Please note: paper or emailed documentation will no longer be accepted.** All documentation must be submitted electronically using the link provided on the program webpage.

Proof of Healthcare Certification must be submitted each application year. Documentation from a previous application will not be carried forward or accepted.

Deadline to submit Optional Items is the last day of Spring Semester (A/C Terms) as listed on the [college calendar](#).

## Competitive Admissions Tie Breaker

In the event of a tie in total admissions points, the following criteria will be used in order to determine admission.

1. The applicant with the higher total GPA of all pre-requisite courses will be ranked higher
2. If a tie remains, the applicant with the higher composite TEAS score will be ranked higher.
3. If a tie remains, the applicant with the higher score on the TEAS science section will be ranked higher.

## **Summer Semester Deadline Items**

Deadline for these items is the last day of Summer Semester as listed on the [college calendar](#). These items must be completed, but are not used to calculate admissions points. Students may apply to the program pending completion of items by the end of Summer Semester. Courses taken during Summer Semester will meet this deadline.

## **Instructions for Optional Observation Hours**

### **Radiography Program**

Applicants may complete an optional six (6) hour observation in a diagnostic imaging department to earn ten (10) bonus points toward competitive admission.

#### **Purpose:**

Observation hours are designed to provide applicants with:

- A firsthand understanding of the daily responsibilities of a radiographer.
- Exposure to patient care, equipment operation, and workflow in a clinical imaging environment.
- An informed perspective to confirm their interest in the radiography profession.

#### **Requirements:**

- A total of six (6) observation hours must be completed in a hospital or medical imaging center under the supervision of a registered radiologic technologist (R.T.(R)).
- The observation must be completed within 12 months prior to the application deadline (2026 forms already on file will be eligible for 10 bonus points).
- Observation hours are all-or-nothing — partial hours will not be accepted, and no partial credit will be awarded.
- All observation experiences must be documented on the official Radiography Observation Form, signed by the supervising technologist.
- Dress Code: Applicants must wear medical scrubs or business casual attire during observation hours. Jeans, shorts, t-shirts, leggings, and open-toed shoes are not permitted.

#### **Submission Instructions:**

1. Obtain the Radiography Observation Form from the program's admissions webpage (See below)
2. Contact a hospital or imaging center to request permission to observe. Applicants are responsible for arranging their own observation experience.
3. Complete the six-hour observation in one or two sessions (as permitted by the facility).
4. Have the supervising technologist complete and sign the verification form.
5. Submit the completed and signed form by via link provided on the program page.

## Important Notes:

- Observation hours are optional, but applicants are strongly encouraged to participate.
- Applicants who complete and verify the full six-hour observation will receive ten (10) bonus points toward their admissions score.
- Facilities may require additional documentation (e.g., proof of vaccination, confidentiality agreement, or background check). Applicants must comply with all facility policies.
