



Banner web PIN to log in



4. Determine what materials (books, articles, reference materials you need to complete your assignment; follow the instructions in the appropriate section of this brochure to access these materials.
5. Don't let it happen again! See the "**I Plan to Work From Home** section of this brochure.

## I Need Books

1. Click on Library Catalog on the CTC Library homepage.  
 CTC LIBRARY CATALOG
2. Enter search terms (words or phrase, title, author, etc.); select **Electronic Book Library** under the library: pull down; submit the search.
3. Review results— select any **Online Resource** book,
  - click on the URL or the 
  - **Ebrary & Credo Reference** enter your **student ID #** to view the book.
  - **EBSCOhost**: Username: **chattech** & Password: **GALILEO Password**
  - **Project Gutenberg** ebooks are free

## I Plan to Work

### From Home

#### What do I need to do?

- Learn how to **Access your Online Library Account** (over) – **you'll be able to access all CTC library online resources** from home as long as your account is active;  
**or**
- Visit any CTC library **once a semester** to get GALILEO, Facts On File, Global Road Warrior, or Newsbank **passwords**.

With the GALILEO password, access journal, magazine and newspaper articles from any of the GALILEO databases, and access other resources, for example:

- **Encyclopedias**— log into GALILEO, click on Databases A-Z tab, select E, scroll down to Encyclopedia Britannica Online; **or** Select C, scroll down to Credo Reference
- **Literary Criticism**— log into GALILEO, click on Databases A-Z tab, select L, scroll down to Literature Resource Center (Gale) or Literary Reference Center
- **Images** — log into GALILEO, click on Databases A-Z tab, select I, scroll down to Image Quest; Millions of images available for non-commercial educational purposes
