College Admission

Students seeking admission to the Medical Assisting Program must be fully admitted to the college by spring semester 2013 and enroll in the college's *Healthcare Science Certificate* to take pre-admission courses. Students must also have all transfer credit entered into CTC's Banner System by **Thursday, May 23, 2013.**

Students interested in receiving <u>Associate's Degree in Medical Assisting</u> must meet the college level general education requirements. Students meeting the criteria for the Associate's Degree will have the opportunity to petition for graduation to receive an Associate of Applied Science in Medical Assisting upon completion of all the degree requirements. **All students, regardless of pre-admission courses, will be awarded a Diploma.*****

Admission into the program is competitive and based on the following admission criteria and deadlines.

Pre-admission General Education Courses

The overall GPA of the *five* (5) pre-admission courses listed below must be **2.5 or higher**. Courses must be completed or transferred into CTC's Banner system by **Thursday, May 23, 2013** to be considered for admission into the program. <u>Students may only take a class twice</u>. The higher of the two grades earned will be used to compute the **competitive GPA**.

***Upon graduating from the MA program, all students will receive a Diploma in Medical Assisting. Students must again petition for graduation to receive the Associate of Applied Science in Medical Assisting. This will be awarded the following semester if all coursework has been completed. <u>Students must take at least one general education course under the AAS in Medical Assisting</u> <u>program of study.</u>

<u>HOBET</u>

Take the Health Occupations Basic Entrance Test (HOBET) Version 5.0 by **Thursday, May 23, 2013.** Students must achieve a total composite score of <u>52 or higher</u> in order to be considered for the program. A HOBET score is valid for five years and CTC will use the highest score.

A student may take the HOBET <u>two (2) times in a calendar year</u> and <u>must wait a minimum of 30 calendar</u> <u>days</u> in between attempts. If a student has more than one recent HOBET score the college will consider the higher score for admission into the program.

The HOBET is a standardized test that measures the student's ability in math, reading, grammar and science. A study guide and practice test can be purchased at <u>www.atialliedhealth.com</u>.

Application Session

To apply to the program you <u>must attend</u> an Application Session during Spring Semester 2013 to complete a program application. The sessions will be held at the Appalachian. Dates, times and room locations for the Application Sessions are posted the Medical Assisting webpage.

Final Class Selection

In the event that there are more qualified applicants than the cohort can accommodate, the students' results on the HOBET will be used to select students for admission into the program.

Completion of the application process and prerequisite courses does not guarantee a student a space in the Medical Assisting program. Admission is competitive and is based on the student's results of each component of the selection criteria.
