



The TCSG Foundation Information Technology Scholarship Program

Scholarships are vital to drive students to industries where workplace demand exceeds the supply of skilled workers. Scholarship support for students interested in computer information systems (CIS) and health care technology (HIT) training is critical for increasing the pipeline of IT professionals and to increasing a student's academic and workplace success. Scholarships that enable CIS and HIT students to enroll full time will shorten their program completion time as well as raise their completion rate.

The TCSG Foundation Computer Information Systems (CIS) scholarship will be awarded on a competitive basis to Technical College System of Georgia students enrolled in CIS or HIT programs. Students will be awarded up to \$1000 per semester (maximum of \$2000 per academic year, including summer) to be used for any out-of-pocket educational expenses not covered by the Hope grant/scholarship, Pell grant, Veterans' benefits, or other financial aid that the student receives.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to qualify for a scholarship provided from The TCSG Foundation CIS Scholarship Program, a student must:

- Be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the state of Georgia;
- Be enrolled in a TCSG college CIS certificate, diploma, or degree program (program group 0360) or in the Health Information Technology program (program group 0250);
- Have a GPA of 2.5 and have earned at least 15 hours in desired program area;
- Demonstrate in an essay (500 words or less) how this scholarship will benefit the applicant and his/her future educational plans.

Selection: The Technical College System of Georgia Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will select and shall notify the scholarship recipient.

Termination: If the recipient fails to enroll, withdraws from the college or does not maintain eligibility requirements, the Technical College System of Georgia Foundation will select another student if time permits; otherwise, funds will be held in the Donor's account to be carried over to the next semester.

Award: Two scholarships of \$1,250 each are to be awarded each semester. Funds are to be used for tuition, books, or program supplies. Before funds will be disbursed, the Technical College System of Georgia Foundation Office must receive a note of thanks from the recipient to the donor(s) to be mailed by the Foundation Office.

Fall Semester Award: Postmarked by June 15*

Spring Semester Award: October 15*
