

Health Care Assistant Medical Billing and Coding Specialization

<u>Program Location:</u> North Metro Campus (Hybrid format) – Fall start

College Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Medical Coding Specialization of the Health Care Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college and enrolled in the college's *Health Care Assistant Certificate* to take designated courses. Once <u>all</u> courses are completed, students will be able to petition for graduation to receive a Health Care Assistant Certificate.
