

Disability Support Services: Accommodations and Adjustments

Support services, accommodations and adjustments may include but are not limited to:

- Special placement test administration
- Textbooks in alternate format
- Testing modifications to include extra time, quiet or isolated testing, readers and scribes Accommodation letter to instructors
- Note takers
- Assistive technology to include Dragon Dictate, Zoom Text, JAWs, reading software, SmartPens, FM Listening Devices, OVAC magnifiers
- Tape recorder/permission to tape record a class
- Interpreter as well as remote and in-class captioning services
- Information and referral to campus and community support services as well as information on community resources
- Access to our Success Centers
- Preferential seating
- Faculty and staff consultation
- Counseling services
- Workshops and materials on effective study and test-taking skills
- Classroom accessibility
- Enlarged print and copy services

Classroom Accommodations: Upon request, each classroom can be equipped with the following:

- Adjustable desks
- Large screen monitors
- Speaking, reading and enlargement software
- Wheelchair accessible desks
- Arm rests and foot rests
- Copy and book stands
- Ergonomic chairs
- Laptops and speakers for remote captioning
- Magnification aids
- Other assistive technology, as needed
- All main building entrances and even some side entrances have electronic door openers and double doors and/or low poundage pull rates with accessible handles.
