Paramedicine Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree

Option for individuals who graduated from another accredited OR non-accredited program

College Admission

1. Individual must complete the college’s application process.
2. Must be able to provide a transcript verifying completion of a Paramedic education program.
 - a. This should be submitted with the application documents
3. Must submit transcripts from any other post-secondary education.

Course transfer and Course Credit

1. The college will award transfer credit for General Education courses based on the college’s policy.
2. The college will award credit for Paramedic courses in a “Block Credit” if the applicant is a current NR-PAR and has a current Georgia Paramedic License.
 - a. Verification of the Paramedic credentials will be completed by CTC’s EMSP Program Director.
