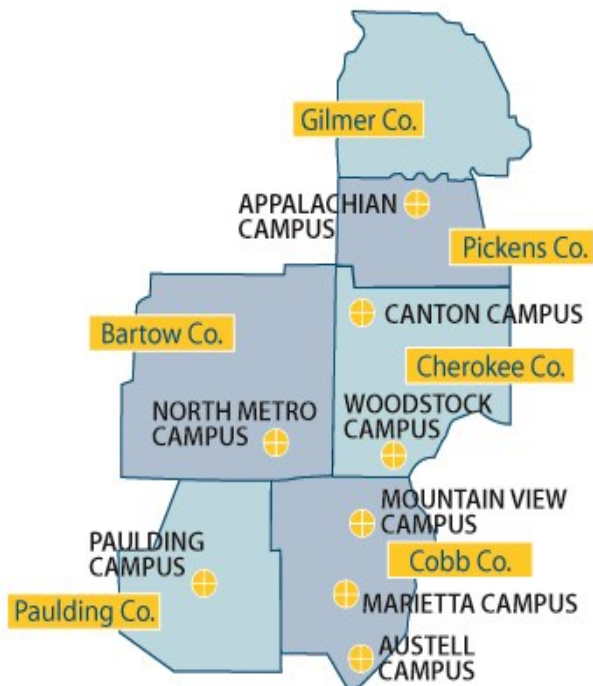

Bright From The Start provides financial help through its "SCHOLARSHIPS" program for childcare staff and family daycare home providers who work in licensed centers or registered homes. SCHOLARSHIPS pays, directly to the institution, 80% of fees not covered by HOPE or PELL if enrolled in a public two- or four-year institution in an early childhood care and education program of study.

SCHOLARSHIPS also provides a cash stipend of \$200, directly to the teacher each semester or \$150 each quarter that he/she is enrolled in an eligible program.
