CNA Admission:
Students seeking admission to the Nursing Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college and enrolled in the College's Certified Nurse Assistant Certificate (CN21) program.

Students should be aware that certain immunizations, negative drug screens and clean background checks are required for participation in the clinical portion of NAST 1100. Students are able to complete this certificate in one or two semesters.

Two Semester Option:
The following classes must be taken in the correct order when registering for NAST 1100 Nurse Aide Fundamentals. The following pre-requisite or co-requisite courses must be completed or have transfer credit by Monday, May 13, 2019 with a grade of "C" or higher:

Suggested courses:
