### To register for an exam follow these steps:

Secure an exemption exam application form from Student Affairs with the necessary information from that office; it must have a signature from both a student affairs and bursar (cashier) office employee.

Pay the non-refundable fee (25% of tuition) as the cashier's office at one of the following campuses: Marietta, Appalachian, North Metro, or Paulding.

After completing the first two steps, send an email to [Paula.Gronemeyer@ChattahoocheeTech.edu](mailto:Paula.Gronemeyer@ChattahoocheeTech.edu) stating the exam, time, campus, date, and your student ID number. Your student ID number must be included in the email.

Scheduling 48 hours prior to the examination time is required—this must be done through email.

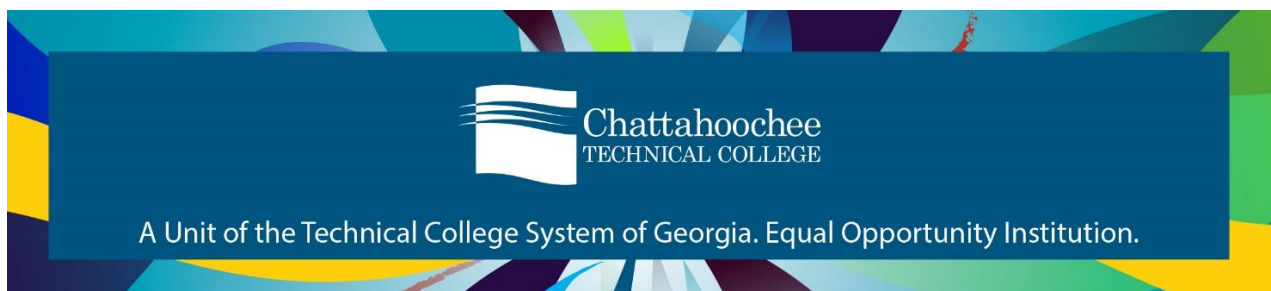
Bring the exemption exam form, a paid receipt, and a picture ID to the exam site.
