Textbook Lending Application Instructions

The Textbook Lending Library is a service provided to eligible students to assist them with the financial burden of purchasing textbooks for their courses. To be eligible for the Textbook Lending Program, students must be a documented member of one or more of the student groups serviced by the Office of Student Resources:

- 1. Economically Disadvantaged
- 2. Students with Disabilities
- 3. Displaced Homemaker
- 4. Limited English Proficiency
- 5. Enrolled in a Non-Traditional Program

- 6. Single Parent
- 7. Homeless
- 8. Active Military
- 9. Foster Care

To Apply for Textbook Lending Program:

- 1. Complete the Textbook Lending Application linked at the bottom of the Textbook Lending Program webpage.
- 2. Check your CTC Student Email for notification from the Textbook Lending team.
 - a. Please note: Students may or may not receive all of the books they have applied for based off eligibility and availability.
- 3. If approved, schedule your appointment to pick up your textbook(s) through the appointment link included in your notification email.
 - a. Students who miss their appointment without notification, will have their books re-shelved and available for other students who are eligible.
 - b. All students will not be eligible. Students who are ineligible will be notified by an email from Textbook Lending sent to the student CTC email account.
