Landmark 1 – the journey begins

(Will possibly take 2 or 3 semesters)

Begin taking required General Education core classes based on Accuplacer test scores. It is recommended that any needed learning support classes be taken in the first semester of enrollment.

COMP 1000 – Introduction to Computers

CRJU 1010 – Introduction to Criminal Justice

CRJU 1030 – Corrections

CRJU 1040 – Principles of Law Enforcement*

CRJU 1400 – Ethics and Cultural Perspectives*

* Requires completion of Learning support classes or appropriate Accuplacer test score. Once learning support classes are complete you can move on the Landmark 2.

Landmark 2 – the journey continues

(2 or 3 semesters)

Learning support classes must be completed or have the appropriate Accuplacer test scores to complete remaining General Education core classes.

Area I – Language Arts (ENG 11101 – complete first)

Area II – Social /Behavior Sciences (PSYC 1101)

Area III – Mathematics (MATH 1111)

While completing the core classes you should also take the following occupational courses:

CRJU 1068 – Criminal Law for Criminal Justice

CRJU 2020 – Constitutional Law for Criminal Justice

CRJU 2050 – Criminal Procedures

CRJU 2070 – Juvenile Justice

Occupational Electives: a total of 15 hours required (CRJU 1043, CRJU 1050, CRJU 1052, CRJU 1062, CRJU 1063, CRJU 1065, FOSC 1206, CRJU 2060 or CRJU 2110)

Submit application packet for CRJU 2090 or CRJU 2100*

Landmark 3 – nearing the end

(semester before graduation)

To prepare for graduation there are a few items to make sure are completed:

Complete any remaining General Education Core classes

Complete any remaining Occupational Electives

Finalize your Practicum or Externship Approval

Complete and submit your Petition for Graduation

Landmark 4 – journey ends

(semester of graduation)

You are almost at your goal! Just a few more classes until you graduate.

Complete any remaining courses

CRJU 2090 – Criminal Justice Practicum or CRJU 2100 – Criminal Justice Externship

Must have submitted application packet and received prior approval.
