DOCUMENTATION FOR I-20

If you are applying for, or have F-1 student visa, supply the following documentation:

- Submit original financial documentation as required by the U.S. government.
- The school estimates that it will cost \$17,490 USD for 5 terms to study at CTC - Intensive English Program.
- One calendar year equals 5 terms.
- The student or sponsor provide a bank statement verifying that a minimum of \$17,490 USD is available to finance the first year of education. Bank contact information and telephone number printed clearly. Financial documentation must be dated within the last three months.

OBTAINING A STUDENT VISA

- Obtain Form I-20 and a letter of acceptance from Chattahoochee Tech.
- Pay SEVIS I-901 Fee. Currently the SEVIS fee to obtain an F, M, or J visa is \$350. Payment must be paid prior to the visa appointment with the U.S. Embassy. For payment options and further information, visit www.FMJfee.com. Student is required to bring a copy of the SEVIS fee payment receipt (showing proof of payment) to the visa interview.
- Find the U.S. Embassy closest to your home at www.usembassy.gov. Check the consular site to see if there are any special instructions for the consulate you will be visiting.
- Make an appointment with the embassy for the visa interview.

Arrival Information: At the port-of-entry to the U.S., the student will be interviewed again. The earliest date of entry into the U.S. allowed is 30 dates prior to the start date indicated on your Form I-20. The student will not be allowed entry into the U.S. beyond the start date. The student is required to make an appointment (telephone: 770-528-4528 or 770-528-5804) with Chattahoochee Technical College's International Services Office after arrival in Atlanta to complete U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service requirements. An international student orientation will be provided before the term begins.
