Q: Can a graduate from the CTC Dental Assisting program work as a dental assistant in an orthodontic office when he/she finishes the program?

A: Yes. Some orthodontic offices will hire graduates upon completion of the program. Other specialty offices like oral surgeons or pediatrics may as well.

Q: Does CTC help Dental Assisting program graduates find a job after graduation?

A: Yes. CTC has the Office of Career Development that will assist enrolled students and alumni in implementing career goals by creating opportunities to connect with potential employers.

Q: How long does it take to become a dental assistant?

A: The typical student that follows the course curriculum is done in five semesters.
