ATI TEAS (Version 6) Minimum composite score of 70	This category is required. Limited to 2 attempts per calendar year; minimum 30 days between attempts.			
Required by Tuesday , June 30 , 2020	Students who achieve a minimum individual total adjusted score of 70 on the ATI TEAS are able to continue in the application process and take the ATI Critical Thinking Entrance Exam.			
ATI Critical Thinking Exam Minimum composite score of 70	Students must achieve a minimum composite score of 70 on the ATI Critical Thinking Exam. Qualifying students will be notified via their CTC student email to schedule this exam.			
Anatomy and Physiology I Required in CTC Banner by Monday, May 11, 2020	This category is required. Higher grade used to awards points. Note: Students are allowed two attempts in the Anatomy and Physiology courses that will be awarded as admission points.
