## **Summer Student Information**



May 18, 2020

Summer classes officially begin Monday, June 1. Registration for summer classes will be open until Wednesday, May 20 at midnight with tuition and fees being due before 1 PM on Friday, May 22. Final registration will open on Monday, May 25 and will remain open until Wednesday, May 27 at midnight. The final registration payment deadline is 1 PM on Friday, May 29.

The vast majority of Summer Semester courses will be offered online; courses that meet on campus will follow as many COVID-19 related public health recommendations as possible.

Face coverings are required of all faculty, staff, students and visitors while on campus when not socially isolated from others.

The first week of classes (June 1-5), all classes will be on-line. Students will complete assignments via the <u>Blackboard</u> learning management system. Additionally, spring students who received an "I" grade will be allowed on campus, with coordination with spring faculty, to complete spring course work. Summer classes end on Friday, July 31.
