CTC GPA Requirement	All students must have a CTC GPA of <b>2.0</b> or higher to be considered for program admission. If a student has all transfer credit, and does not have a CTC GPA, this requirement does not apply.	No Points
ATI TEAS (Version 6)  Minimum composite score of <b>75</b>	This category is required. Limited to <b>2</b> attempts per calendar year; minimum <b>30</b> days between attempts.	Max Points 100
Required by <b>Friday, April 2, 2021</b>	Students who achieve a minimum individual total adjusted score of <b>75</b> on the ATI TEAS are able to continue in the application process and take the ATI Critical Thinking Entrance Exam.	
ATI Critical Thinking Exam  Minimum composite score of <b>70</b>	Students must achieve a minimum composite score of <b>70</b> on the ATI Critical Thinking Exam.  Qualifying students will be notified via their CTC student email to schedule this exam.	Max Points 100
Anatomy and Physiology I  Required in CTC Banner by  Tuesday, May 11, 2021 to earn admission points	This category is required. Higher grade used to awards points.  Note: Students are allowed two attempts in the Anatomy and Physiology courses that will be awarded as admission points. Should a student attempt these classes more than twice, only the first two attempts will be considered when calculating admission points.  BIOL 2113	Max Points 50

Anatomy & Physiology II	This category is optional prior to program admission.	Max Points 50
Required in CTC Banner by Tuesday, May 11, 2021 to earn admission points.	All students that are admitted into the program that have not taken Anatomy & Physiology II BIOL 2114 and BIOL 2114L must complete the course with a grade of C or higher by the end of the 1 <sup>st</sup> semester of the Nursing Program. Courses are required for program completion.
