TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION

High School Transcripts: Submit official transcripts from your high school and all colleges attended by the application deadline. All transcripts must be received in envelopes sealed by the sending institution.

College/University Transcripts: Applicants with a college degree will send college transcripts from all colleges attended but are not required to submit a high school. All international transcripts must be evaluated by an approved evaluation service and sent directly to CTC.

- For high school transcripts or diplomas submit a document by document evaluation or General evaluation.
- Students with college credit or a degree from a college or university outside the United States must submit a course-by-course evaluation of the transcript.
- Documents not in English need to be translated.
- We will accept evaluations from NACES and AICE member agencies.

DOCUMENTATION FOR I-20

If you are applying for, or have F-1 student visa, supply the following documentation:

- Submit official scores from one of the following placement tests taken within the last 5 years SAT, ACT, ASSET, or Accuplacer.
- Submit original financial documentation as required by the U.S. government.
- The school estimates that it will cost \$21,527 USD to study at CTC for one academic year. One academic year equals 2 academic semesters or 8 months.
- The student or sponsor must provide a bank statement verifying that a minimum of \$21,527 USD is available to finance the first year of education. Bank contact information and telephone number printed clearly. Financial documentation must be dated within the last three months.

OBTAINING A STUDENT VISA

- Obtain Form I-20 and a letter of acceptance from Chattahoochee Tech.
- Pay SEVIS I-901 Fee. Currently the SEVIS fee to obtain an F, M, or J visa is \$350 USD. Payment must be paid prior to the visa appointment with the U.S. Embassy. For payment options and further information, visit www.FMJfee.com. Student is required to bring a copy of the SEVIS fee payment receipt (showing proof of payment) to the visa interview.
- Find the U.S. Embassy closest to your home at www.usembassy.gov. Check the consular site to see if there are any special instructions for the consulate you will be visiting.
- Make an appointment with the embassy for the visa interview.

Arrival Information: At the port-of-entry to the U.S., the student will be interviewed again. The earliest date of entry into the U.S. allowed is 30 dates prior to the start date indicated on your Form I-20. The student will not be allowed entry into the U.S. beyond the start date.

The student is required to make an appointment (telephone: 770-528-4528 or 770-528-5804) with Chattahoochee Technical College's International Services Office after arrival in Atlanta to complete U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service requirements.

An international student orientation will be provided before the term begins. See acceptance letter for date and time.
