

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA)

On February, 18, 2021 a letter was sent to the student body about CTC's plan for the disbursement of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) of 2021. CTC planned a two-stage process for the disbursement of funds. In stage one, students with a qualifying EFC on their FAFSA were automatically awarded \$500. Stage two began on March 12, 2021. In this stage eligible students could apply for aid if the pandemic caused financial need for the student.

Originally, the application was scheduled to close on April 12, 2021. CTC has made the decision to leave the application open for an additional three weeks, until May 3, 2021. CTC will also now accept applications from dual enrollment students. All students who were not previously awarded in stage one or stage two are encouraged to apply if the pandemic has caused financial hardship.

Eligible students must (still) be enrolled for spring semester, must not be a visiting transient student and must not be coded, for residency purposes, as an international student.
