CNA Admission:

Students seeking admission to the Nursing Assistant Certificate must be fully admitted to the college and enrolled in the College's *Nurse Aide Accelerated (NAA1)* program.

Students should be aware that certain immunizations, negative drug screens and clean background checks are required for participation in the clinical portion of NAST 2100. Students are able to complete this certificate in one or two semesters.

The following class must be taken in the correct order when registering for NAST 2100 Nurse Aide Accelerated. The following co-requisite course must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher or have transfer credit prior to registering for NAST 2100:
