

TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION

High School Transcripts: Submit official transcripts from your high school and all colleges attended by the application deadline. All transcripts must be received in envelopes sealed by the sending institution.

College/University Transcripts: Applicants with a college degree will send college transcripts from all colleges attended but are not required to submit a high school. All international transcripts must be evaluated by an approved evaluation service and sent directly to Chattahoochee Tech.

• For high school transcripts or diplomas, submit a document by document evaluation or General evaluation.

- Students with college credit or a degree from a college or university outside the United States must submit a course-by-course evaluation of the transcript.
- Documents not in English need to be translated.
- We will accept evaluations from NACES and AICE member agencies.

DOCUMENTATION FOR I-20

If you are applying for, or have an F-1 student visa, supply the following documentation:

- Submit official scores from one of the following placement tests taken within the last 5 years SAT, ACT, ASSET, or Accuplacer.
- Submit original financial documentation as required by the U.S. government.
- The school estimates that it will cost \$21,610 USD to study at Chattahoochee Tech for one academic year. One academic year equals 2 academic semesters or 8 months.
- The student or sponsor must provide a bank statement verifying that a minimum of \$21,610 USD is available to finance the first year of education. Bank contact information and telephone number printed clearly. Financial documentation must be dated within the last three months.

OBTAINING A STUDENT VISA

- Obtain Form I-20 and a letter of acceptance from Chattahoochee Tech.
- Pay SEVIS I-901 Fee. Currently, the SEVIS fee to obtain an F, M, or J visa is \$350. Payment must be paid before the visa appointment with the U.S. Embassy. For payment options and further information, visit www.FMJfee.com. In addition, the student must bring a copy of the SEVIS fee payment receipt (showing proof of payment) to the visa interview.
- Find the U.S. Embassy closest to your home at www.usembassy.gov. Check the consular site to see any special instructions for the consulate you will be visiting.
- Make an appointment with the embassy for the visa interview.

Arrival Information: At the port of entry to the U.S., the student will be interviewed again. The earliest date of entry into the U.S. allowed is 30 dates before the start date indicated on your Form I-20. The student will not be allowed entry into the U.S. beyond the start date. The student is required to make an appointment (telephone: 770-528-4528 or 770-528-5804) with Chattahoochee Technical College's International Services Office after arrival in Atlanta to complete U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service requirements. International student orientation will be provided before the term begins.

INTERNATIONAL SEVICES

International Services is the resource center for international students to obtain information and student services concerning international admissions, visa advisement, immigration documents, orientation, and international student programs.
